

# Syracuse Elem. Quarantine Plan

## Dear Syracuse Elementary Families:

In an effort to predict the unpredictable, we would like to share our plan in the event your student, our classes, or our school is quarantined due to Covid-19 or other illness. We are fully prepared to offer your students the opportunity to continue their learning even when they cannot be with us physically. Please read the plans carefully so you will know the options available to you in case of quarantine. These guidelines are for Health Department quarantines or soft closures, not for self-imposed restrictions. Teachers are not required to provide a separate curriculum for students who choose to stay home. Options provided by Davis School District are:

- Attendance at the student's assigned school;
- Davis Connect Classroom Online School with a remote teacher;
- Davis Connect Independent Study.

If you are nervous about in-person school attendance, please fill out the [Davis Connect K-6 Emergency Enrollment Form](#) to apply for online school.

Families are welcomed to access what is available on teachers' Canvas pages. If your students have extended absences (more than 5) which are not prescribed by the Health Dept., we respectfully ask that you contact the office, 801-402-2600, to let us know your individual choice and circumstances. Please know that we care about each of our students and want to be sure they are okay!

## Three Types of School Quarantine

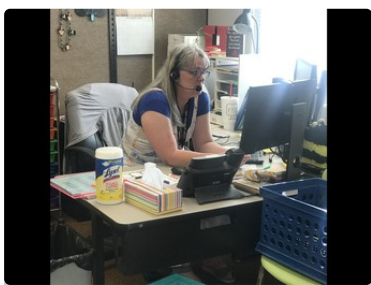
### Individual Quarantine

An individual quarantine means a student is quarantined as the result of an exposure. Work will be provided through Canvas where quarantined students may do the work classmates are doing in class. Teachers will



be teaching in person Monday - Thursday and will not be providing individual instruction for students on quarantine.

- Questions about work may be emailed to the teacher who will reply within 24 hours.
- Students will access Canvas to find assignments from their teacher.
- Teachers will help catch up with quarantined students on Fridays.
- Some classroom experiences cannot be replicated at home. Teachers may choose to excuse a quarantined child from the activity or allow them to join through a Teams or Zoom call.



## Whole Class Quarantine

When a class has 3 or more active cases, a whole class will be required to do a quarantine for 14 days. The expectation is that the whole class will work remotely and students will spend the following time working on remote work:

Kindergarten: 60 minutes per day, M-Th, on priority skills -

Reading/Math with other subjects integrated into priority areas.

Grades 1-3: 120 minutes per day, M-Th, on priority skills -

Reading/Math with other subjects integrated into priority areas.

Grades 4-6: 120 minutes per day on priority skills -

Reading/Math/Science with other subjects integrated into priority areas.

Fridays: Teachers will work with students a minimum of one-hour on Fridays. Individual teachers will schedule times with whole class, groups, or individuals. The majority of the day will be reserved for teachers to work on preparing digital curriculum for students.

## Soft Closure (Whole School Quarantined)

The building is closed but teachers and students continue remotely with teaching and learning. Classwork for all grade levels will be provided primarily through Canvas.

Kindergarten: 60 minutes per day, M-Th, on priority skills - Reading/Math with other subjects integrated into priority areas.

Grades 1-3: 120 minutes per day, M-Th, on priority skills - Reading/Math with other subjects integrated into priority areas.

Grades 4-6: 120 minutes per day on priority skills - Reading/Math/Science with other subjects integrated into priority areas.

Fridays: Teachers will work with students a minimum of one-hour on Fridays. Individual teachers will schedule times with whole class, groups, or individuals. The majority of the day will be reserved for teachers to work on preparing digital curriculum for students.



## Special Education Services During Quarantine





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Students who receive Special Education Services will receive their services remotely. Teachers will communicate the expectations in accordance with the child's Remote Learning Plan. Time spent on IEP goals may be a combination of face-to-face instruction through Teams and independent practice in Canvas. For example, the iReady programs children use in math and reading will provide strong math and reading experiences tailored to your child's needs.

Note for Resource: In some cases, the resource teachers may want to coach during the morning session. They will work out and communicate the daily schedule.

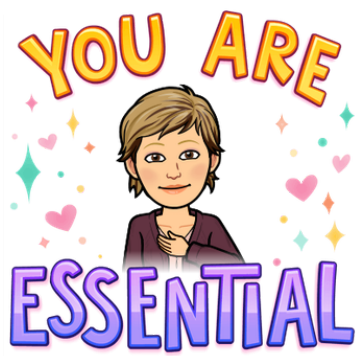
